## HIRING OF CHR/CHW

Being the only Community Health Representative (CHR) at the Pueblo of Tesuque was a COVID-19 Emergency preparedness problem and barrier. It was difficult to transport clients/patients because it kept me away from the office and created many time constraints. Flyers were delivered house to house for COVID-19 updates and safety notifications because there is limited wi-fi services in the community. Keeping up with paperwork was difficult because of fieldwork. It was important to make deliveries to community members for their food, supplies and medication. COVID-19 activities can cause burnout and fatigue, so it is beneficial to have another CHR work with our program.

Worked with Human Resources and Health & Wellness Division Director to hire a CHR. The process took a 1 month. A CHR was hired in July. This will make transports and medication delivery easier. She will assist with deliveries when we have go out delivering flyers, food and so forth. I can breathe better and am more relaxed that some on the duties will be shared with the new CHR.
